APPENDIX 1

County Councillor Report:

County - Full Council:

As you will no doubt be aware the County Council has had two meetings of the full council since the County Election, the first where the cabinet roles were appointed and chair of the council selected. The 16th July was a fairly lengthy meeting with a lot of public questions and motions to council, appointing of honorary alderman and some procedural changes to meetings. Next week is full council for September and the agenda is a number of motions.

I have submitted a motion to full council in support of Adopted and Special Guardianship Children which will also be on the Agenda, if councillors are particularly interested I am more than happy to send you a copy of the motion. In brief it is calling for more help for Adopted Children after the Government cut the funding for their support.

Roads and Highways:

I have had two meetings with the Highways manager for our areas Max Kelly. I need to have further meetings with him to cover our very large division but Max was the existing highways manager for most of the new Severn Vale division so does have a good understanding of the roads and pavements here.

I recently arranged an emergency meeting with Colin Chick, Jo Walker CEO and the Council leader to raise concerns about the multiple road closures locally which do not seem to take account of the major road closure between Cleeve and the Racecourse. This resulted in a pausing of road works near prestbury which was impacting residents. I have had assurances that only essential works will take place.

I have also set up a roads and speeding survey with our MP Cameron Thomas. This is for residents across the constituency to be able to raise with us any road and highway safety concerns. We have also created a petition to County Highways for a safety review of the A38, this was following a meeting with County Highways officers where they suggested that although there have been a number of accidents and fatalities on

certain stretches of this road, we would need to demonstrate public support for this to be fully reviewed by highways. I have shared the survey and petition online and will also be sharing through a residents newsletter in due

Councillor Surgeries:

I committed during the election to being available for residents across the constituency both online and in person. I have therefore set up a number of Councillor surgeries across the Severn Vale which I hope will ensure that residents from across our large division are able to meet with me to raise questions, concerns and ideas about the things they would like to see in our county. If any parish councillors would like to join me at any of these you would be more than welcome. My surgery meeting date are going to be held on the last Saturday of the month so the coming dates are 26th July, 30th August, 27th Sept, 25th October.

10am-11 New Location to be confirmed 11:30am-12:30 The New Dawn Inn, Norton. 1pm-2pm Shurdington Community Hall. 2:30pm Bishop's Cleeve Library.

Borough and County Grass Cutting:

There have been some issues in some areas of Tewkesbury Borough regarding the cutting of County Council Grass by Tewkesbury Borough Council and that the ending of this contract has caused loss frequent cutting leading to frustration from some residents. I confirmed at Borough Executive that the borough will look to bring a paper in July which temporarily reinstate grass cutting where needed, this has now been approved. This involves working with local borough councillors to identify the priority areas. We will then have a further paper in the Autumn to look at a more long term solution. I hope this is helpful and please work with your district councillors on this if

you need help in this area. Cllr Agg and Adcock will be able to work with you on this to make requests as needed.

Fostering and Children's Services:

The County has just announced it has received a 'Good' OFSTED inspection. Whilst this is obviously good news, as a member of the Children and Families scrutiny committee I will be keen to scrutinise the full report, see where the council can still improve and to continue to raise the importance of ensuring all Children in Gloucestershire receive the best possible care.

Homelands Community Building:

(I know not Stoke Orchard but close by in Cleeve so may be of service to residents in Stoke Orchard) This is Borough related not County but I thought you would be pleased to know that TBC have appointed charity 'Move More' to run the building. This is an important step in getting the building ready for opening for the public. The building will be available for community use and hire.

Local Government Reorganisation:

There is/was a public engagement survey which I hope you have been sent a copy of. The Survey is not a full consultation on the options and is more around engagement to give people the opportunity to feed into the process with further work to follow. It would be really helpful. The close for this was Saturday so I am hoping you all got to see this before the close: Link here

Timeline for what is happening now and next:

Proposals are currently being worked on for 1 & 2 Unitary Councils (including a
Cheltenham proposal of East/West split and a Gloucester proposal for a Greater
Gloucester). My preference as Tewkesbury Leader is for a One Gloucestershire
Model but I am constructively inputting to One and East/West, (I have not seen
an Gloucester proposals yet to contribute towards).

- 28th November Gloucestershire to Submit Final Proposals to the Secretary of State
- 2026 Onwards Secretary of State makes Structural Changes Order
- 2nd May 2027 Elections to the shadow authority Responsible for County Functions and Transitions only
- April 2028 Vesting Date for new councils, current 2 tier ceases to exist and new council assumes all responsibility.

I am happy to give a fuller update at the next meeting but hopefully you are accessing information on this through the Association of Town and Parish Councils. There will also be a district council, town and parish council seminar session later in the year to cover LGR.

Elmstone Hardwicke Odours from drains

I have had a number of meetings with Vistry and neighbouring parish councillors to raise the issue of odours coming from the drains into people's properties since the Coombe Hill Estate was developed. I know not in Stoke Orchard but I thought you may be interested to know as it is close to you and drains all linked.
